### 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to LATFALEC '26, a premier transport and logistics event that brings together industry leaders, innovators and stakeholders to shape the future of Transportation in Lagos and beyond. Building on the success of our inaugural event in 1994, organised in collaboration with the Federal Ministry of Transport and Chakbay Ventures Limited, we are proud to revive this flagship exhibition and conference to address the evolving needs of the sector.

### 2. OBJECTIVES OF THE EXHIBITION AND CONFERENCE INCLUDE:

1. Networking opportunities: Connect with professionals, thought leaders and potential partners.
2. Knowledge Sharing: Learn from experts and share best practices in logistics and supply chain management.
3. Innovation Showcase: Discover the latest technologies, products and services in the industry.
4. Business Development: Generate new leads, meet potential clients, and expand business opportunities.
5. Education and Training: Enhance skill and knowledge through workshops, seminars, and conferences.
6. Market Research: Stay updated on industry trends, challenges, and opportunities.
7. Brand Promotion: Increase visibility and promote products or services to a targeted audience.
8. Policy Discussion: Engage in discussions on industry policies, regulations, and standards.

These events provide a platform for industry professionals to achieve these objectives and stay competitive in the market. The 2026 exhibition and conference which has its theme **“IMPROVING THROUGH TRANSPORTATION”** has the following objectives:

- j. Suppliers of transport and logistics accessories and auxiliary services.

These organizations and professionals attend the conference to network, learn about industry trends, and discover new logistics and transportation solutions.

### **4. CONFERENCE**

With the theme “**IMPROVING THROUGH TRANSPORTATION**” the Lagos transport freight and Logistic Exhibition and Conference will explore every major subject affecting the carriage of tangible and intangible, within our state and the rest of the world. Delegates from all over the state will be expected at the conference to participate in lively debate with internationally renowned experts. Great interest is already being expressed in this exciting event, which has been eagerly expected to throw fresh light on the subject of major significance to the future well being of the state.

### **5. TERMS OF REFERENCE**

In the terms of contract, the term “Exhibitors” includes company, partnership, firms and individuals, to whom space has been allocated for the purpose of exhibition.

The term “Organiser” shall mean Honor Fi-Shadai Ventures Limited and NACIMA. The term “Contract” means the agreement between the organisers and the exhibitors for the use of Exhibition space which incorporates the terms of contract and the rules and regulations that may subsequently be issued.

## **6. CONSTRUCTION OF PAVILIONS**

The exhibition ground will be available to participants from three days to the commencement of the exhibition for the purpose of pavilion construction, decoration and mounting of exhibition materials.

If exhibitors shall not store or dispose of packaging materials in any way that constitute nuisance, obstruction to free movement of people and traffic or disfigure the environment around the area.

Pavilion hall shall be dismantled and allocated space vacated not later than two days after the closing date of the exhibition.

## **7. APPLICATION FOR SPACE**

All applications for space shall be made on the prescribed application form or website with all documents to: Honor El-Shadai Ventures Limited, Block 35, Flat 3, Ojojo Low Cost Housing Estate, Meiran, Ifako-Ijaiye, Lagos, Nigeria together with evidence of payment. Once signed the Exhibitors contract shall then be binding on both parties.

## **8. ALLOCATION OF EXHIBITION SPACE**

The organisers shall allocate the space in accordance with the nature of the exhibits or in the manner they think appropriate. The organisers shall reserve the right to change the space allocated to the Exhibitors at any time prior to the commencement of the build-up of the Exhibition, should exceptional circumstances demand. Such changes shall be at the discretion of the organisers and the Exhibitors shall have no claims for compensation as a result of the change.

## **9. USE OF EXHIBITION SPACE**

Exhibitors are bound to display the exhibits indicated in their applications forms and to man the stand with competent personnel during the opening hours of the exhibition. The organisers have the right to refuse admission to the exhibition to any person. Exhibitors are not expected to sub-let the stand allocated to them to other parties either wholly or in part without the written consent of the organisers. Exhibitors will be liable for any damage to the exhibition ground in which their exhibits are placed and shall not paint or otherwise deface or alter or fix to the floors, ceiling, pillar or walls without the consent of the organisers.

## **10. METHOD OF PAYMENT**

All payments due for the exhibition and conference in respect of space rented, charges for utilities and advertisement in the Exhibition and Conference Catalogue or Website shall be payable to “Honor El-Shadai Ventures Limited”, FCMB A/C 2007472735.

Payment can be made by Bank transfer, Bank deposit or any other payment platforms as will be agreed with the organisers.

All payments should be received not later than one month to the opening of the exhibition.

## **11. CONSTRUCTION AND DECORATION OF STAND**

Exhibitors will be allowed to construct or decorate their stands as laid down by the organisers. All the exhibitors must complete their construction or decoration by the date and time stipulated by the organisers. Any damage caused by an exhibitor or his contractor or employee or agent to the property of any other exhibitor or to property of the organisers or the Landlord shall be the responsibility of such Exhibitor who shall make good at his own expense all such damages.

## **12. MOVEMENT OF EXHIBITS**

- a. Exhibitors shall bear the responsibility and expenses of transportation of exhibits to the Exhibition venue.
- b. Exhibitors shall remove all exhibits from the venue within the period stipulated by the organisers, and shall indemnify the organisers against any loss by reason of delay or damage.

## **13. SECURITY**

The organisers shall take all reasonable security precautions in the interest of exhibitors and visitors. However, the organisers shall not be held responsible for any loss, theft or damage to exhibits displayed, stands or other property at the Exhibition.

## **14. INSURANCE LIABILITY AND RISKS**

Exhibitors shall insure, indemnify and hold the organisers and the Landlord harmless with respect to any costs, claims, demands and expenses to which he may be subject as a result of loss or injury arising to any person whatsoever caused while such person(s) are upon or examining or passing the Exhibitors stand during the duration of the Exhibition. The liabilities and risks of his employees, agents or exhibits shall be the responsibility of the exhibitors. Exhibitors shall be placed at the Exhibitors own risk and the organisers shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage occurring to any exhibitor or property of any exhibitor from any cause whatsoever. Exhibitors are advised to fully insure all exhibits during occupancy of exhibition ground.

## **15. BREACH OF CONTRACT AND WITHDRAWAL BY EXHIBITOR**

Without prejudice to the rights and remedies of the organisers in respect of any breach of contract on the part of the Exhibitor, the organisers may at their discretion allow the Exhibitor to withdraw from the exhibition subject to the following conditions.

- a. An Exhibitor may give notice in writing to the organisers to withdraw from participating in the Exhibition.
- b. In the event of failure by the Exhibitor to pay the balance of space charges upon their due dates, the allocation of space made to him may be cancelled.

c. Upon the cancellation of an allocation for the above reason or upon receipt by the organisers of a request by an Exhibitor to withdraw from participating in the exhibition, any payment made by the Exhibitor for space charges will be dealt with as follows:

i. An Exhibitor whose allocation is cancelled or who gives notice of his desire to withdraw from participating in the exhibition, after space allocation has taken place, shall, if such cancellation is made or such notice is received by the organisers not later than 28th February, 2026 forfeit 15% (fifteen percent) of the charge for space allocated.

ii. After the 28th February, 2026 and up to the 15th April, 2026, the Exhibitor shall be liable to pay 55% (fifty five percent) of the charge for the space allocated.

iii. An Exhibitor whose allocation is cancelled or who gives notice of withdrawal after the 15th of April, 2026 shall be liable for 100% (one hundred percent) of the charge for the space allocated.

d. In the event of any failure on the part of the Exhibitor to observe and perform any of the provisions of the contract, the organisers shall have the right to terminate the contract forthwith by written notice to that effect in which event all charges then paid by the Exhibitor shall be forfeited and retained by the organisers and the Exhibitor shall indemnify the organisers for all costs, losses, damages or expenses including any consequential loss or damage incurred as a result of such failure.

## **16. CHANGE**

The organisers reserve the right to change the venue and duration of the exhibition if unforeseen circumstances so demand. In the event of change of venue or duration, the agreement to take part shall remain valid in so far as the Exhibitor is notified at least one month before the change. In the event of cancellation of the exhibition, the organisers at their discretion may pay some compensation to the Exhibitor.

An alternative venue may be sought for the conference, where it does happen, it shall not exceed ten minutes drive from the exhibition venue.

## **17. SUPPLEMENTARY CLAUSE**

Whenever necessary, the organisers shall have the right to issue supplementary regulations in addition to those in the TERMS OF CONTRACT to ensure the smooth management of the exhibition. Any additional written instruction shall form part of the TERMS OF CONTRACT and they shall be binding on the Exhibitors.

**18. Exhibitors shall not assign this TERMS OF CONTRACT without the express consent of the organisers in writing.**

**19. Any Exhibitor that used more space than booked or will be liable to pay for the extra space utilized.**

**20. Any dispute, difference or question which may arise at anytime thereafter between the organisers and the Exhibitors touching on the true construction of this TERMS OF CONTRACT or the rights and liabilities of parties hereto shall be determined by Honor El-Shadai Ventures Limited.**

## **21. PROHIBITED AND UNDESIRABLE EXHIBITS**

The Exhibition Authority prohibits the display or sales of the following during the exhibition:

- a. Explosives and inflammable materials
- b. Firearms and ammunition
- c. Any Exhibitor wishing to use or demonstrate with petrol, fuel oil, paraffin, ethyl alcohol, acetylene or operate any machine/equipment likely to cause explosions and fire outbreak shall be required to obtain the approval in writing of the Fire Brigade Authority. Exhibitors are also advised to provide Fire Extinguishers.
- d. Demonstration with heavy moving machines or equipment shall be undertaken only at stipulated intervals, and shall take place within an area safely protected. The Exhibitor shall be expected to exercise control of such moving machinery or equipment.
- e. The Exhibition Authority may disallow an Exhibitor from demonstrating to the public any equipment or materials which is not in compliance with rules.

## **22. REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS**

Exhibits must be removed not later than two days after the exhibition. Thereafter, Exhibitor will be liable to charges from the Exhibition Organisers.
